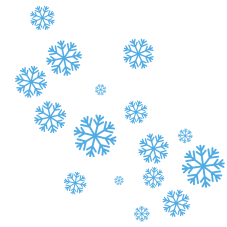

Happy New Year!! Thank you to all the December Leaders of the Day! January will be the month to explore winter and shapes. We'll begin by celebrating the New Year and then jump right into shapes.

Winter has certainly arrived and we would like to remind you of our inclement weather policy. When faced with potentially dangerous weather conditions, Preschool will follow the Fort Mill School District's decision on closings. Information about closings is also relayed to the primary radio and television stations in Rock Hill and Charlotte. Please note that Fort Mill is located in the York County School District 4. (We have several friends who live in the Indian Land community and they are listed under the Lancaster County School District so be sure to check the Fort Mill School schedules). We will also post closures through our GroupMe app.

If FMSD is delayed for any amount of time, preschool will be CLOSED for the day. Should inclement weather occur after preschool begins, we encourage parents to pick up their child as soon as possible.

Our class will begin “swimming” on Wednesday, February 12th.

Every Wednesday in February, March, April, and May the children will swim.

- Swim suits should be worn under clothing each water play day. It is very important to label all items of clothing and towels for easy identification. Leaving it up to children to identify clothing may not be a reliable source, please label all items.
- Swim bags should be large enough to hold the child’s towel, clothes and shoes. Clothes should be easy on/easy off as children will be encouraged to dress themselves with as little assistance as possible from the teachers, thus nurturing independence.
- Velcro or slip on shoes should be worn on water play days. A bath size towel (beach towels are too big and bulky) is just right for small hands to manipulate after water play.
- The water in our pool (the 2 to 3 foot pool) is heated and the air temperature is approximately 80 degrees.
- American Red Cross trained life guards are on duty during our swim time. Safety is our number one concern!

Summer Camp Registration will begin in January. Our Little Hoots Preschool Camp is for children ages 3-5 years old. Our hours of camp will be Monday-Friday, 9:00am-12:30pm. See dates for registration below!
