Happy New Year!! Thank you to all the December Leaders of the Day! January will be the month to explore winter and shapes. We'll begin by celebrating the New Year and then jump right into shapes.

Ways to practice at home...look for shapes in the real world. For example, street signs, windows, pans, etc. We will also continue to practice identifying our names and the order of the letters... ways to practice at home... pointing to each letter, mixing up the letters and have your child put the letters in the correct order. To help build your child's finger strength in preparation for handwriting, we also suggest playing with play dough at home. Making playdough snakes and pinching the play dough to form objects or letters is great practice for your little one's fingers. You can also have your child trace letters in flour on a cookie sheet, or salt spread on a cookie sheet to help them with fine motor skills.

Winter has certainly arrived and we would like to remind you of our inclement weather policy. When faced with potentially dangerous weather conditions, Preschool will follow the Fort Mill School District's decision on closings. If FMSD is delayed for any amount of time, preschool will be CLOSED for the day. Should inclement weather occur after preschool begins, we encourage parents to pick up their child as soon as possible.
