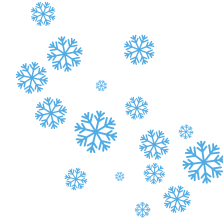




## January 2025 News 4 Year Old Classes



We will begin our New Year exploring winter activities, animal habits during the winter, our alphabet letter, our number of the week, and begin to add a shape of the week. Please remember to talk about the letters and numbers with your child. When writing letters with your child be sure to practice both the upper and lower case letters. We encourage practice at home! Also, any reading at home you do will greatly increase your child's vocabulary! This will be a great help to your child when he/she enters kindergarten.

Our letters of the month will be 'J,j', 'D,d', 'P,p', and 'B,b'.

Winter has certainly arrived and we would like to remind you of our inclement weather policy.
